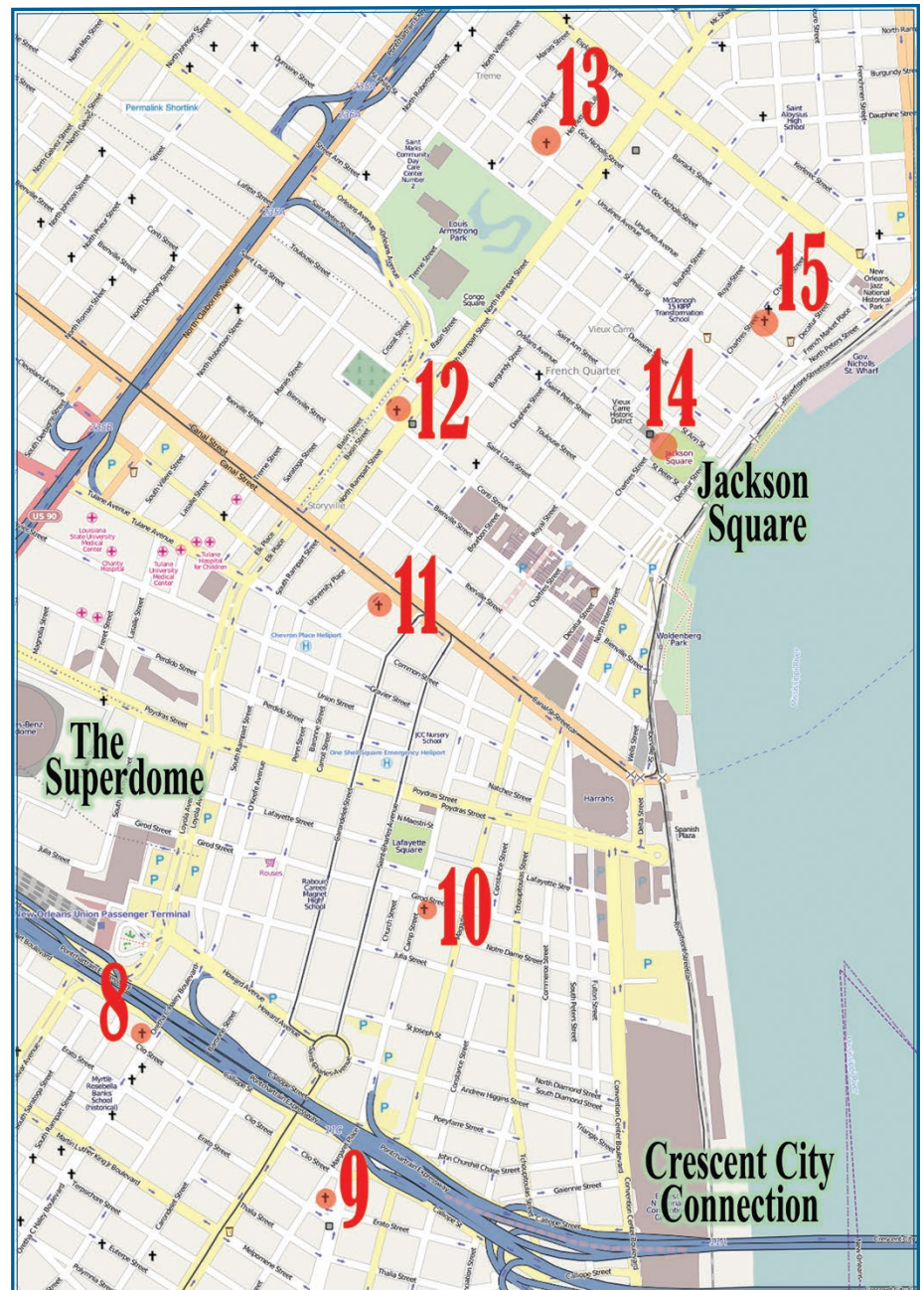


# Good Friday 'walk' options range from 9 to 15 churches

- **3. St. Katharine Drexel,** 2015 Louisiana Ave.; opens 9 a.m.; Passion Liturgy, 3 p.m.; Stations and confessions, 4 p.m.
- **4. Our Lady of Good Counsel (Center of Jesus the Lord),** 1307 Louisiana Ave.; opens 8 a.m.
- **5. St. Mary's Chapel,** 1516 Jackson Ave.; opens 8 a.m.
- **6. St. Alphonsus,** 2030 Constance St.; opens 8 a.m.
- **7. St. Mary's Assumption,** 923 Josephine St.; Stations, noon; Passion Liturgy, 3 p.m.
- **8. St. John the Baptist,** 1139 Oretha C. Haley Blvd.; opens 7:30 a.m.
- **9. St. Theresa of Avila,** 1404 Erato St.; opens 8 a.m.; Stations and Passion Liturgy, 12:10 p.m.

- **12. Our Lady of Guadalupe,** 411 N. Rampart St.; opens 6:30 a.m.; confessions, 10 a.m.-noon; Live Stations, noon; Passion Liturgy, 3 p.m.
  - **13. St. Augustine,** 1210 Gov. Nicholls St.; opens 7:30 a.m.; confessions, 11 a.m.-noon; Stations, 2 p.m.; Passion Liturgy, 3 p.m.
  - **14. St. Louis Cathedral,** 615 Père Antoine Alley; opens 8:30 a.m.; Stations, noon; confessions, 12:30-2:30 p.m.; Passion Liturgy, 3 p.m.
  - **15. St. Mary's (Italian),** 1116 Chartres St.; opens 8:30 a.m.; closes, 3 p.m.
- Many Catholics make a special devotion on Good Friday by walking to nine churches to pray and reflect on the passion and death of Jesus Christ. This map provides an easy guide for a Good Friday pilgrimage, showing the location of 15 churches that can be used to make the walk. The St. Charles Avenue streetcar can be used to return to St. Stephen Church after completing the nine-church walk. Feel free to make up your own devotional route. ## Northshore churches set for car 'pilgrimage'; St. Roch info

Unless you're a marathon runner, it's unlikely you could make the nine-church "walk" on the northshore without a car. However, Lisa Charitat, a parishioner at St. John of the Cross in Lacombe, has confirmed that the following nine churches/shrines on the northshore will be open by 8 a.m. on Good Friday:

**St. Anselm,** Madisonville; **St. Benedict,** Covington; **St. John of the Cross,** Lacombe; **Our Lady of Lourdes Shrine,** Lacombe; **St. Luke the Evangelist,** Slidell; **St. Margaret Mary,** Slidell; **Our Lady of Lourdes,** Slidell; **St. Genevieve,** Slidell; and **Sts. Peter and Paul,** Pearl River. Two other churches, **Mary Queen of Peace** in Mandeville and **St. Peter** in Covington, will open at 8:30 for morning prayer.
